specified City projects to the agenda. Vice Member Hill seconded the motion.

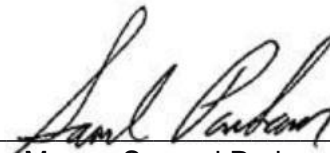
There was no discussion on the motion. The motion was approved by a unanimous affirmative vote of all present.
